

#### PASTOR'S NOTES:

Last weekend I announced my transfer to St Mary parish Rochester, and St Peter parish Farmington. I wanted to explain a little more what happens now as the process of finding your next pastor unfolds. Monday morning emails went out to all priests of our diocese letting them know that our parishes will need a new pastor- along with parishes in Somersworth and Rollinsford. With those emails were our finance reports and our spiritual reports, both of which we submit to the diocese each year. Priests can look these over and think about whether they might like to come here.

Some people asked what the spiritual report is, and I realized that pretty much only us on staff would know what that is. This report includes how many people and families are registered in our parishes-which is why we try to get you to register when you start coming! It also includes how many seats we have in Church and how many people are filling those seats on a regular weekend. Also how many children are in Religious Education classes, what type of music ministry do we have, what type of charitable activities do we do, what kinds of prayer groups are active...all different aspects of our spiritual life are covered in this report.

A few weeks after the information is given to our priests, the Priest Personnel Board meets. They consider the needs of our parishes, whether any pastors are interested in coming here, and who they think might do well for parishioners. This sometimes takes more than one meeting. The Board makes a final recommendation to Bishop Libasci, who considers it, and makes the final decision. The priest under consideration may be called by someone from the Personnel Board to see if he has some strong reason for not moving, which becomes part of the discussion. Once the bishop makes his decision, the formal appointment letter goes out with directions about the announcement and transition date. All this can take a few weeks, or even more than a month. Once the appointment of your new pastor happens it will be announced at all weekend Masses at both parishes.

As I said, I will be praying for you during this process, and you should pray too that the Holy Spirit guide those involved so as to find a new shepherd for God's flock here in the 'Currier and Ives scenic byway' area of our diocese.
