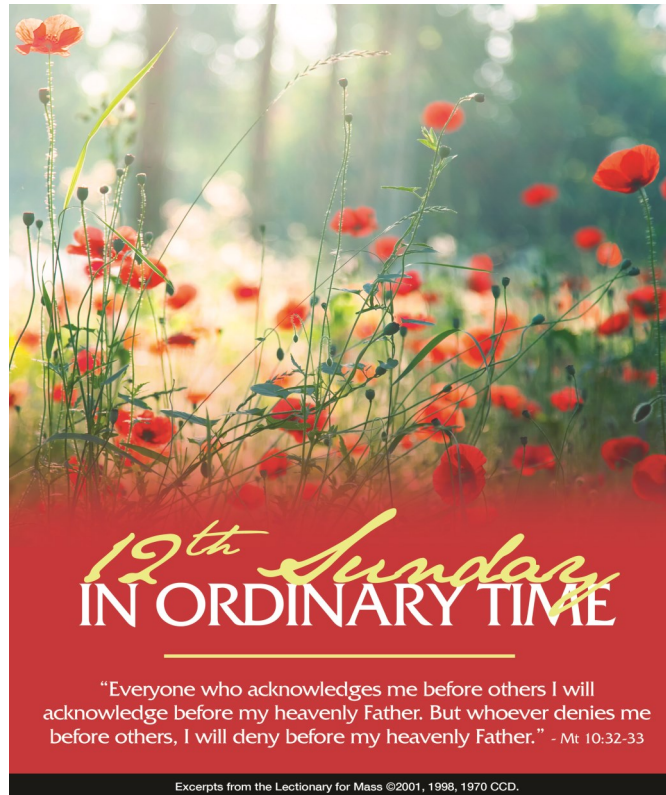

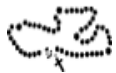

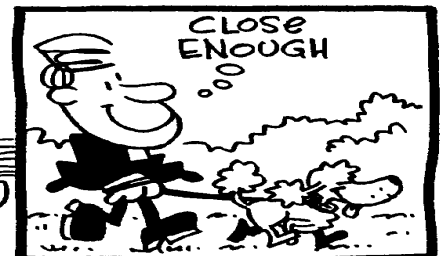

Bishop Peter A. Libasci ordained Rev. David A. Harris and Rev. Matthew J. Schultz to the priesthood at St. Joseph Cathedral in Manchester on Saturday, June 3.

Bishop Libasci said, “This is a moment of profound spiritual joy for me, and for all the Catholic faithful in New Hampshire. These two young men will, as the psalmist says, ‘take up the chalice of salvation and call upon the name of the Lord,’ and lay down their lives for the salvation of souls through the Sacrament of Holy Orders.

“I hope that all Catholics throughout our state will join me in praying for Fr. Harris and Fr. Schultz as they begin their new lives as priests, and in praying for an increase in the numbers of men who will also follow God’s call.”

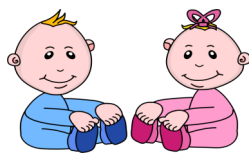
