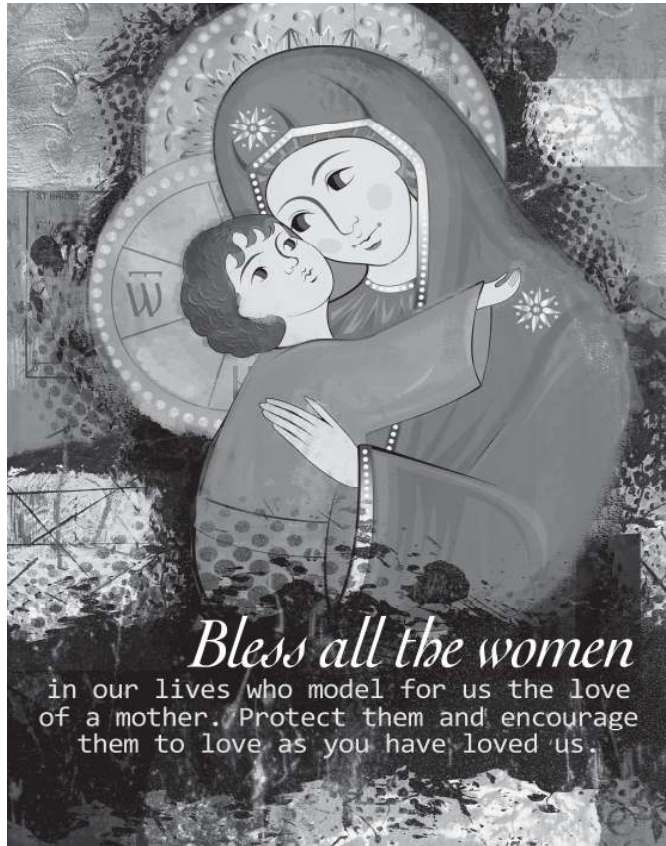

Baptism: Performed on the first Sunday of the month. Please make arrangements in advance by contacting the parish office.

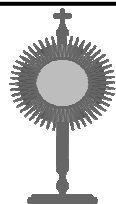
Marriage Preparation: Arrangements must be made at least six months in advance. Please contact the parish office prior to making other arrangements.

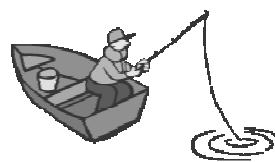

A REMINDER FROM FR. THOM:

Pope Francis released the document *Amoris Laetitia* last month. This is the Holy Father's exhortation to all members of the Catholic Church *On Love in the Family*. Bishop Libasci has asked all of us to read it and reflect on how we can better live out our call to love in our families and in the world. I was thinking that it might be helpful to treat it like a parish book club since the document is 256 pages long. We will have two opportunities for discussion. The first will be on the first four chapters (up to page 125), and the second on the whole document. There will be an evening session and a daytime one for each meeting. The first one will be either Wednesday evening, June 1, from 7-8 pm at St Mary Rectory or Sunday, June 5, from 1-2 pm at St Theresa parish hall. By those dates I will have dates for the second sessions!

For anyone with a tablet the easiest way to get the document is to go to the Vatican web site www.vatican.va and download it. It can also be printed from there, but remember how long it is.

There, now I really have to sit down and read the whole thing! I look forward to your thoughts on it.
