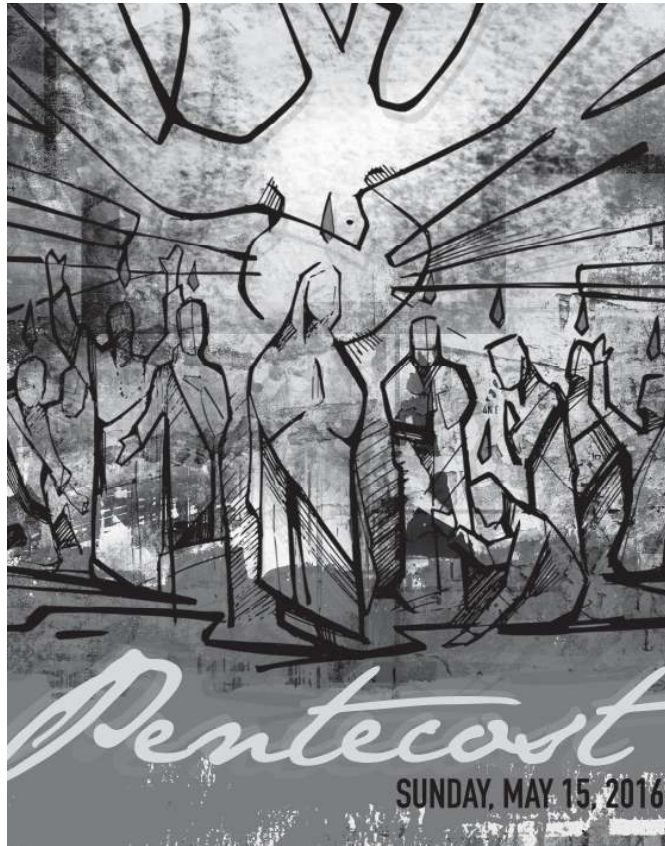

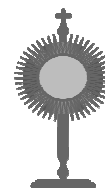

I wanted to remind you that the feast of the Sacred Heart is coming on June 3. For those who wish to place an image of the Sacred Heart in their homes, we will need to bless them at Masses on May 28/29. This is also Memorial Day weekend and the change over to our Summer Mass schedule! Don't worry if you miss this because the enthronement can happen any time, it is just preferable to do it on the actual feast day. The things that need to be done are to find the image that you want to have permanently in your home, to have it blessed, and then to have prayers with your family as you place the image and ask Jesus to watch over your family with His love. I will make sure that we have something you can use by that week.

At times like this it is perhaps more important than ever to pray for the refreshing of the Holy Spirit in my life and in our lives. As we gather this weekend let us indeed pray-Come Holy Spirit! Enkindle in our hearts the fire of Your love!
