**BISHOP PETER LIBASCI ORDAINS TWO MEN  
TO THE TRANSITIONAL DIACONATE**

Bishop Peter A. Libasci ordained Rev. Mr. David Harris and Rev. Mr. Matthew Schultz to the transitional diaconate at St. Joseph Cathedral in Manchester on Saturday, May 28.

Bishop Libasci said, "This is a joyous moment for the Catholic Church in New Hampshire. These two young men are responding in a most profound way to Christ's call to take up the cross and follow Him.

"I am especially grateful to their parents, parish communities, pastors, and others who have fostered their vocations. May God bless them in a special way as these young men take the next step on their journey to becoming priests."

David A. Harris, born August 17, 1983, is a parishioner of Saint Theresa Parish in Rye Beach, and is the son of Dr. Michael and Mrs. Andrea Harris. He grew up in Rye and attended Saint Thomas Aquinas High School in Dover. A 2005 graduate of Providence College, he is entering his fourth year of Theology at Saint John's Seminary in Brighton, MA. He was vested at ordination by Fr. Maurice Lavigne, and has a summer assignment at the Parish of the Resurrection in Nashua.

Matthew J. Schultz, born July 8, 1978, is a parishioner of Saint Patrick Parish in Nashua, and is one of 13 children of Michael and Jane Schultz. He grew up in Norwich, NY, and attended Norwich High School, then earned Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts degrees from the University of Dallas. He is entering his fourth year of Theology at Saint John's Seminary in Brighton, MA. He was vested at ordination by Fr. Lester Smith, and has a summer assignment at Saint Joseph Cathedral in Manchester.

The Diocese of Manchester currently has 10 men preparing for the priesthood at seminaries in Baltimore, Boston, and Providence.

Deacon Wayne and his wife Belinda coordinated the schedule, prayers, and borrowing of the canopy. Marie McGill made sure we were set in Butler Park, which was a good thing because my arms and shoulders needed a rest!
