

From the Pastor's Desk

As we start the month of October, we have several very popular saints' feast days. October first is the feast day of the Little Flower, St Therese of Lisieux. This is followed the next day by a feast day that was very important to her, the feast of our Guardian Angels. OK, the guardian angels are not saints, they are angels, but because of their importance to us and their holiness we do celebrate their feast day. October fourth is the feast day of St Francis of Assisi, who is known and loved everywhere. The month of October is also traditionally dedicated to Mary as well.

What does this mean when we say we are devoted to these holy ones? I think that most simply it is that we recognize that they help and inspire us. In some ways these relationships are like other friendships we have. We don't all have the same friends and interests, so we won't all have the same devotions to the same saints. Some of us may have many devotions, while others have only a few. We may share certain devotions with our fellow parishioners to our parish patron saints, but cultivate other devotions to saints they have never heard of. This is a very natural way in which we participate in the communion of saints.

Speaking of participation, these devotions are something that we choose to do. We may wear a medal of a certain Saint, or carry a prayer card, or have a statue, or read their stories. In this way they inspire us to live our own Christian lives better. When we pray to them or assist at Mass on their feast days, we ask for-and most certainly receive-their help. You may want to look ahead on the calendars we distributed in our parish to see which saints have feast days coming up so that you can prepare to celebrate these holy ones, and take another step in holiness.
