We want to take a moment to thank you all for your service to the Lord through your ministries. Ministry is an important aspect of service to the Church and one aspect of any good ministry is scheduling.

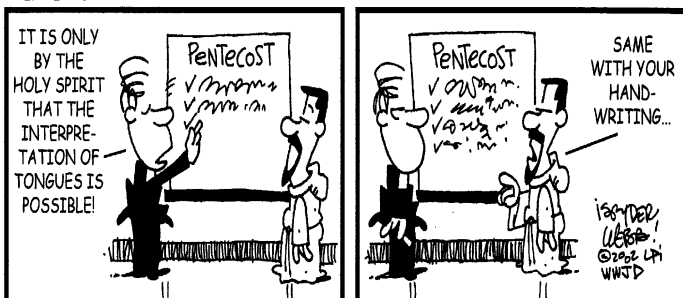

ANNUAL BABY SHOWER

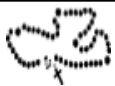
